


Picnic Table Plan






MATERIALS AND TOOLS:

- (7) 2x6" x 12' and (2) 2x4" x 8' pieces of douglas fir or pressure-treated lumber
- (12) sets of 3 1/2" carriage bolts with washers and nuts
- (100) 2 1/2" decking screws, saw, drill, speed square, tape measure



BUILD INSTRUCTIONS:

- Start by assembling the table top upside down on a flat surface
- Connect legs next, checking that table does not wobble when flipped right side up
- Attach the seat last and apply a penetrating stain to the table to extend its life



Use scrap wood blocks to temporarily elevate the legs while attaching
